Scholarship Description

The First Congregational Church of Camden Music Committee has established the 2020 Friends of Music Scholarship to provide financial resources to full-time undergraduate or graduate students majoring in music studies. Scholarship recipient(s) will be announced in the spring of 2020, and scholarship funds will be paid directly to the recipient's school for the 2021 spring term, upon receipt of the recipient's Fall 2020 transcript.

The amount of each annual scholarship award will be at the discretion of the selection committee. The selection committee also retains the right to divide the annual award among multiple candidates or to withhold the award in years in which no qualified applicants apply.

Eligibility

Applicants must be majoring in music at the undergraduate or graduate level. First preference will be given to members of The First Congregational Church, with second preference going to those applicants who can demonstrate a connection to the church via a relative or volunteer work. Previous recipients of the award are encouraged to reapply each year for the duration of their music studies.

Applications will become available on February 3, 2020 via The First Congregational Church of Camden website (www.camdenucc.org). Paper copies of the application will also be available; please contact the Church Office Manager to receive one.
